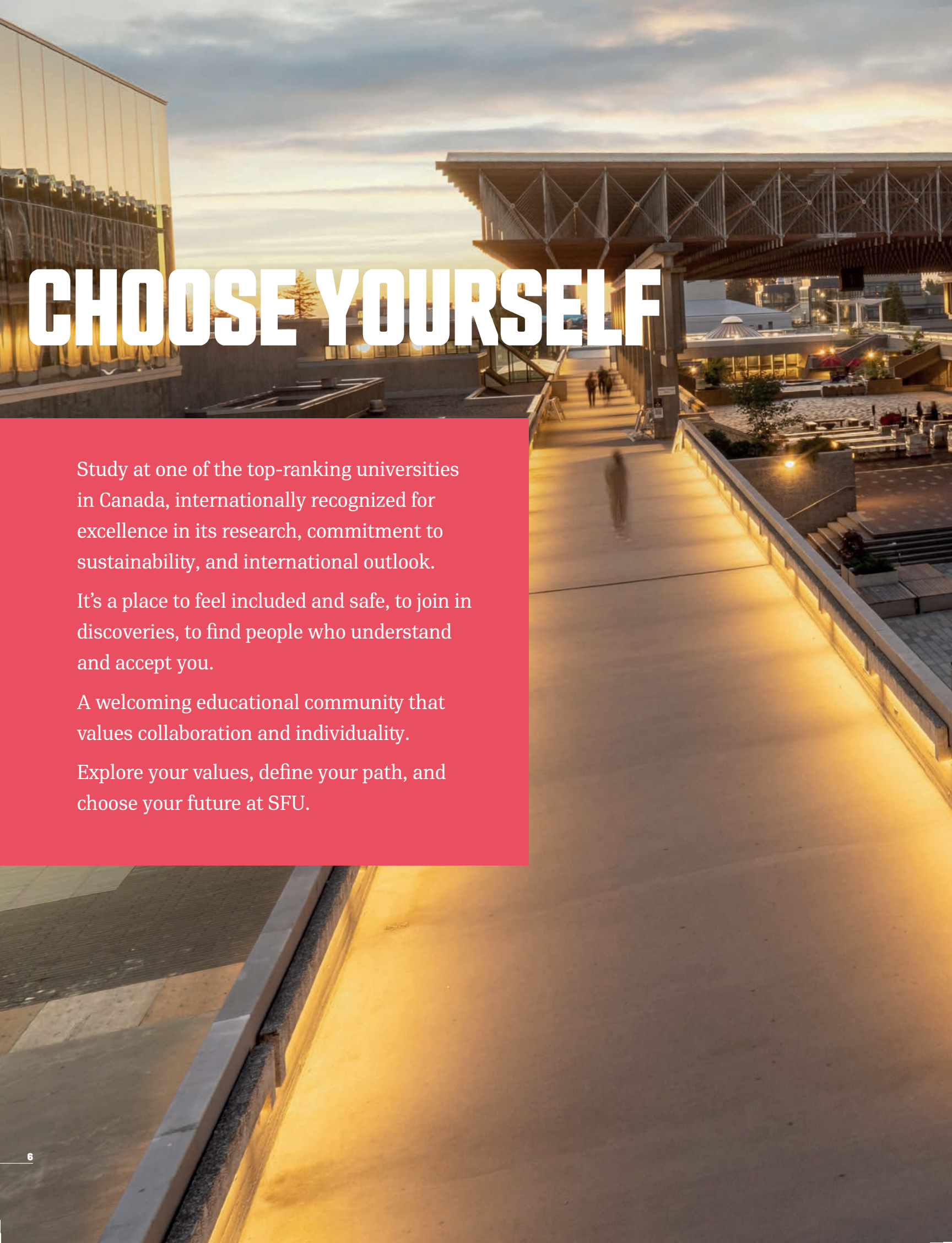

**TIANNA SEQUEIRA**  
FACULTY OF APPLIED SCIENCES

Tianna decided to study in SFU's School of Sustainable Energy Engineering (SEE) because she wanted to actively address environmental challenges through hands-on experience. Drawn to the program's emphasis on cutting-edge research, she was excited by the opportunity to learn skills in engineering and science alongside studies in environmental policy, resource management, and entrepreneurship. An early assignment challenged her group to develop a new product to solve a problem in sustainability. They responded by developing usable composting technology out of a discarded bread maker. This innovative and collaborative experience shaped Tianna's approach to future career aspirations, particularly in bringing sustainability to aerospace. She explored this goal by bringing a sustainable lens to her co-op placements in rocket design and at the Canadian Space Agency working on the Lunar Gateway space station.

*"I found that my vision really aligned with my peers in SEE. I thought, 'these are the people I want to be working with.' our driving question is how can we decrease the impact our technology has on the earth? I've always wanted to work in aerospace, but I want to do so by bringing a clean tech and environmental perspective to the industry. Clean tech in aerospace is a growing field with a lot of potential."*

You can start researching and planning your courses for the fall.

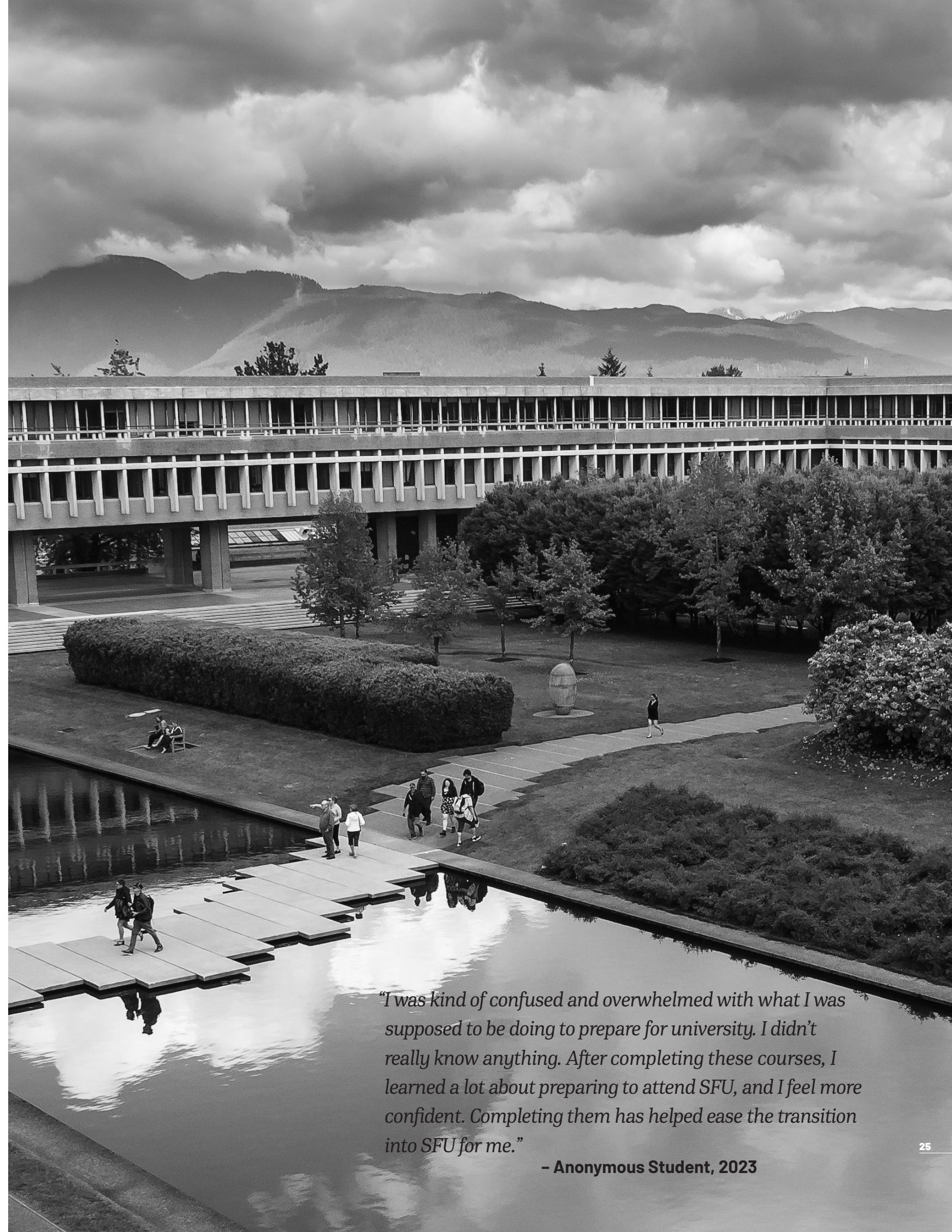
### WE'LL GET YOU READY FOR YOUR FIRST TERM

## APPLY

### 1. FIND YOUR PROGRAM

When you apply for admission to SFU, you will choose a faculty and a program. Whether or not you already know what you want to study, our website has descriptions and career information for all our programs.

### 2. CHECK YOUR REQUIREMENTS

Admission requirements vary depending on:

- Which program you want to study
- Where you're currently studying
- What curriculum you're studying

Our admission website lists the specific requirements for all programs across a variety of curricula.

You'll also find special admission information for Indigenous and International Baccalaureate students.

### 3. MEET THE END OF JANUARY DEADLINE

Most students start at SFU in the fall term (September), but you can also apply to start in the spring (January) or summer term (May).

High school students can submit applications for September 2025 starting on October 1, 2024.

The application period closes on January 31, 2025.
