INTERNATIONAL POSTGRADUATE SUMMER SCHOOL WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD

The International Postgraduate Summer School, co-host by Lingnan University in Hong Kong and the University of Oxford in the UK, consists of one week of study at Lingnan, plus a further two weeks of study at Hertford College, the University of Oxford, for selected students. The summer school programme offers an international group of students the opportunity to establish their own research clusters and enrich their research experiences by sharing their interests while learning from world-renowned scholars. The one-week programme at Lingnan University also offers a series of workshops which focus on various research and methodological issues, as well as student presentations, field visits and social activities.



Close faculty-student relationship

Lingnan adopts a student-oriented teaching and learning approach, and emphasises close faculty-student relationship. We stress interactive teaching and learning modes that mobilise students to reach for higher levels of intellectual discourse, analytical thinking and independent research capability. Likewise, we also adopt innovative teaching and learning approaches that include internships, overseas field trips, immersion language studies, directed research projects, cooperative learning and action learning.

Internship Programmes

Students who wish to explore their career interests, upgrade their resumes, and gain insight into their preferred career choices prior to graduation, should take advantage of our internship programmes. Overseas internship programmes, and internships in Mainland China, give students the opportunity to broaden their global perspective by undertaking practical work outside of Hong Kong. These programmes also help students to understand cultural differences, become more inclusive, and become more aware of global issues, as well as improving their foreign-language skills.

Local internships allow students to gain a hands-on experience of the dynamic local work environment. Local work experience enriches students' professional knowledge and generic skills in the workplace, and enables them to network with associates and professionals. Internship experiences prior to graduation can strengthen a student's overall employability.

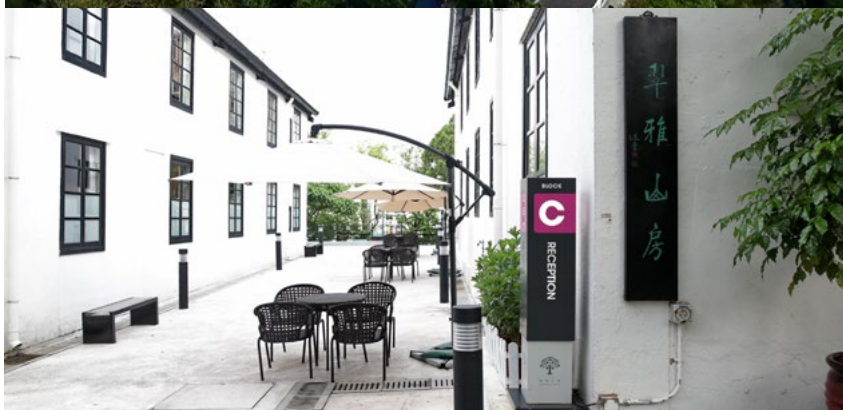

Located in Lai Chi Kok, the Heritage Lodge is only a few minutes' walk from MTR station - where there are lots of local shops, eateries, convenience stores and supermarkets - with easy connections to the heart of the city (9 minutes to Mong Kok, 22 minutes to Central).

Dual Degree of Doctor of Policy Studies and PhD of Education Policy/Administration

- DPS is Hong Kong's first Doctorate in Policy Studies. The programme has flexible delivery modes and strong experiential learning elements including field visits, and academic workshops and seminars. Students can expect to visit some of LU partner institutions in the UK, notably the University of Bath and University of Oxford. The programme is particularly suitable for professionals with experience in public administration, education sector, non-governmental organisations, and think tanks.
- The PhD programme in NCCU aims to provide professional training for personnel in the fields of educational administration and policy planning. By integrating knowledge from various domains and the training of advanced social-science research methods, students are able to engage in research theory and topic discussions of higher academic learning and advanced applications.

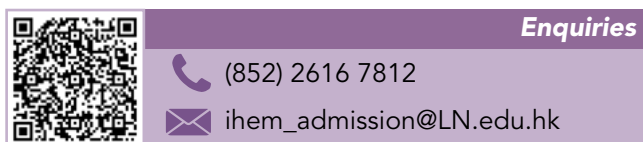

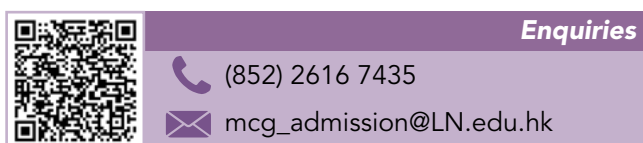
Master of Arts in International Higher Education and Management

- Offers a series of international research workshops and seminars to broaden students' network and ideas by meeting with professionals and top scholars from different counties and regions.



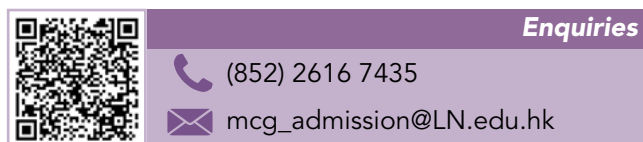
Master of Cities and Governance (Concentration in Environment and Sustainability)

- Students will take part in international research and academic programme-related events.



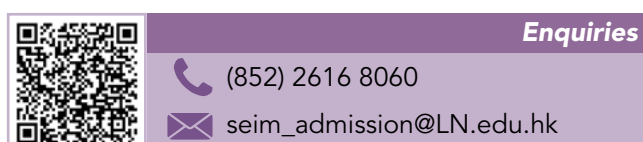
Master of Cities and Governance

Master of Arts in Social Entrepreneurship and Innovation Management

 - o Students will have opportunities for field visits and participate in international conferences and seminars to expose them to current research.
 - o SEIM students can participate in international experiential learning programmes (e.g., summer and winter academies in Uganda, Nepal, and Kazakhstan) and work towards creating real world social ventures solving challenges in these communities.

Master of Science in Health Analytics and Management

- 1 year Full-time / 2-year Part-time programme.
- Inter-disciplinary programme.
- Designed for health care professionals, health service managers and coordinators.
- The Master of Science in Health Analytics and Management (HAM) adopts an eclectic approach to design a professionally led courses aimed at training a modern crop of workforce who has the skills to support the increasingly data-driven and digitalised healthcare sector.
- The HAM aims at providing current and aspiring with data-driven management knowledge and skills to make informed decisions about healthcare and enhance efficient management of health service operations.
- The programme also intends to train students to develop a career-driven practical and research skills in health data analytics and operations management through the professional and technical knowledge.

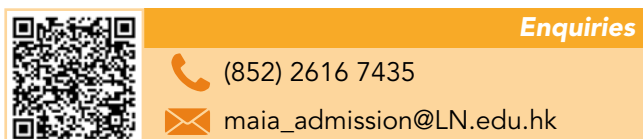

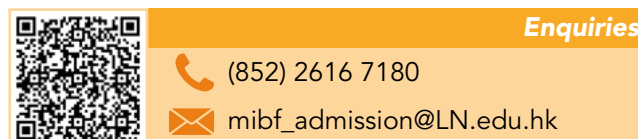
Master of Arts in International Affairs

- Students will have opportunities to attend academic conferences, workshops and public lectures. They can broaden their knowledge and develop a stronger network with the professionals from different fields.



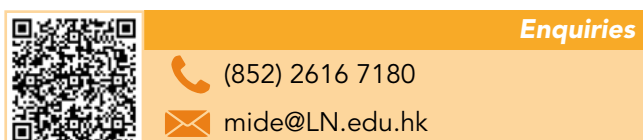
Master of Science in International Banking and Finance

- Offers students internship and overseas study tours opportunities.



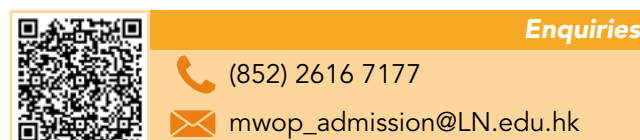
Master of Science in International and Development Economics
