
ABOUT GITIS

Russian Institute of Theatre Arts (GITIS) — is not only one of the biggest in Europe, but also one of the most prestigious schools of drama at home and abroad. GITIS was founded in 1878. However, we value innovation and experiment, we encourage our students to explore all the questions that that affect them as artists today.

GITIS is professional educational institution providing training in every discipline of the arts such as: Acting, Design, Directing, Musical Theatre, Ballet-Master, Variety Show Theatre, Theatre Study, Management and Production.

GITIS has a long history, a well-earned reputation and is a meritocratic institution. Cooperation with international schools and working with students from other countries, we strive to create an international theatre training center based on unique traditions of Russian theatre art. GITIS's graduates consistently succeed at the highest levels of their profession. Its alumni are to be found in all production areas of theatre, film and television, in the music industry, circus, community arts and education organisations.

More than once an entire class founded a theatre upon graduation from GITIS. That was the story of popular now "Helikon-Opera" (1990), "Quartet I" (1993), "Pyotr Fomenko Workshop Theatre" (1993) and "The theatre art studio" (2005).

Among the graduates of recent years there are winners of the Berlin Film Festival Grigory Dobrygin and Sergei Puskepalis (2010); Samal Yeslyamova, the winner of the Cannes Film Festival (2018); Andrei Zvyagintsev, the winner of the Venice Film Festival, the repeated winner of the Cannes Film Festival, "Felix", "Cesar", "Golden Eagle "and twice Oscar award nominee.

Vsevolod Meyerhold, Jerzy Grotowski and Eimuntas Nekrosius were GITIS' notable alumni of the earlier years.

Stafis Livafinos, the current art director of the National Theatre of Greece, is a graduate of GITIS.

Graduates of the Music Theatre Faculty perform at the best world opera stages, and directors stage shows at the Bolshoi Theatre, the Stanislavsky and Nemirovich-Danchenko Musical Theatre, as well as the Metropolitan Opera, La Scala, the Grand Opera, Covent Garden, the Berlin Opera, the Munich Opera, the Canadian Opera (Toronto) and in other famous opera houses.

Important note: All programs are taught in Russian. However we're offering Russian language courses for the applicants. During entrance exams the main attention is paid to the talent of foreign applicants and not to their skills in Russian.

Central heating in Moscow flats (including GITIS dormitory) is not linked to certain dates but to the weather. When the temperature is lower than +8 °C (46 °F) for 5 days the central heating is turned on. Accordingly, when the temperature is higher than +8 °C (46 °F) for 5 days in spring, it's turned off.

Following the foundations laid down by Stanislavsky and Nemirovich-Danchenko classic school, future directors study special theoretical literature, learn to build perception zones and get to know how to engage the viewers. A lot of attention is paid to the organisation of the

rehearsal process, development of the stage composition as well as learning the skill of event-based analysis of literary, dramatic and music texts. These skills are just a few of the elements learned by students throughout the course.

For more than 80 years GITIS has been preparing young scientists working in the area of history and theory of theatrical art in all its forms and genres.

Many well-known theatre theorists have graduated from GITIS and successfully work in research institutes, magazines, newspapers, on television, and teach at Russian and foreign universities.

Nowadays young researchers are improving their knowledge and skills by participating in programmes designed to train scientific and pedagogical staff in postgraduate education. They study the history of the theatre, philosophy and improve their knowledge of foreign languages. Postgraduate students from foreign countries also learn various aspects of the Russian language, and enhance their knowledge of general and professional psychology and pedagogy.

The all-round training helps to create a scientific approach to selected topics. The systematic work on scientific research is conducted under the guidance of experienced programme supervisors and its are discussed at department sessions. Postgraduate students have the opportunity to publish their works in the GITIS almanac "Theatre. Painting. Cinema. Music".



Summer course, 60 hours / 2 weeks, August

Every summer at GITIS we run a series of short courses from two to eight weeks long.

Taught by the same tutors and industry professionals who lead our full-time training, alongside recent GITIS graduates and other visiting artists,

these courses are an intensive experience designed to bring out the best in our summer students.

The summer school takes place at GITIS's main building in the centre of Moscow.





Summer course, 60 hours / 2 weeks, August

During the short-term acting art course students master main elements of the acting profession — attention, stage movement, acting aim, communication, perception, imagination and fantasy, tempo and rhythm, improvisation, nature of conflict. There are

also trainings where students do various exercises to gradually master different elements of the acting art. Upon completion of the course students prepare the final presentation of their works.





Summer course, 60 hours / 2 weeks, August

HOREOGRAPHY

Program consists of three parts: teaching methods of classical, folk stage and historical dance. This course is aimed to prepare students for the independent work in the ballet sphere in accordance with Russian ballet school teaching method, as well as to help them master forms, styles and techniques of the modern dance.

Summer course, 60 hours / 2 weeks, August

Work with directing students consists of two parts — acting art and directing. At acting class students master main elements of the acting profession — attention, stage movement,

GITIS FESTIVALS GITIS actively participates in various international projects and annually hosts its own festivals, conferences, lectures and workshops.

NTERNATIONAL

Participation in the competition is open to students studying theatre directing. They present individual directing works covering proposed topic. Each fragment's duration should be 15-20 minutes.

The aim of the competition and conference is to provide professional

communication and a space to discuss the young directors' education, educational experiences and promote an understanding of the current situation in the theatrical education science.

April

Each year the festival is dedicated to one particular theme relevant to the first two years of an actor's education. The theme is usually announced two months prior to the festival.

Aim: professional communication and dialogue between various theatrical

schools, thereby encouraging an exchange of professional experience. The Festival's programme includes students' presentations from Russian and foreign theatre schools on the following subjects: acting skills, directing, scenic speech, vocal, stage movement, stage dance.



The Institute Library, which houses **350,000 volumes**, has one of the largest collections of theatrical art books in Moscow. In the video library there are recordings of productions from different years, as well as instructional videos made by leading Russian performers and directors.

The dormitory, which houses students, is located next door to a station on the Moscow Metro.

This almanac is a selection of new scientific essays (or their completed fragments), the disclosure of some general problem in the study of a certain direction in art, and a comprehensive coverage of a major phenomenon that has determined new ways.



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To receive an official invitation to study at the Institute send a letter by e-mail: **international@gitis.net** stating your intended course of study, your specialty, your intended student category (undergraduate, qualification-advancement, or graduate), a summary of your education to date, and your passport information (last name, first name, middle name, date of birth, passport number, citizenship).

Upon arriving in Moscow you must present the following documents:

- official transcripts detailing your education to date (translated into Russian and certified by notary)
- medical certificate showing results of the HIV/ AIDS test as well as medical insurance
- 10 photographs

At that time you will have an interview regarding your course of study.

CERTIFICATION OF STUDY

Upon completion of a full undergraduate course of study, the Institute awards a diploma in the relevant specialty.

Students in qualification-advancement status receive a Certificate of Study.

Graduate students, upon successful completion of a dissertation, receive the degree of Candidate of Arts.

GITIS is based in the historical centre of Moscow. Studying at GITIS with the Bolshoy Theatre, Maly Theatre, Tretyakov Gallery, Pushkin Museum of Fine Arts are all close by, meaning students have an array of world-renowned cultural institutions next to them.
