



UNHCR - Refugee Data Mapping

Thank you for your interest in this exercise. Times Higher Education (THE) has partnered with UNHCR, the UN Refugee Agency, to produce the largest global mapping of higher education opportunities for refugees. This survey will allow us to collect the information needed to undertake this mapping exercise.

This mapping will serve as an essential piece of information for governments, relevant ministries, higher education institutions (HEI), and refugee and asylum seeker students to explore and access higher education pathways, and as a vital advocacy tool for raising awareness and solidarity for refugee and asylum seeker inclusion in higher education. This survey will collect data on refugee and asylum seeker enrolments, scholarship opportunities, and practices on empowering refugee and asylum seeker higher education and will support the UNHCR's strategy to achieve 15% enrolment of refugees in higher education by 2030.

For the purposes of this exercise:

A **refugee** is any person who meets the eligibility criteria under an applicable refugee definition, as provided for in international or regional refugee instruments, under UNHCR's mandate or in national legislation. Under international law and UNHCR's mandate, a refugee is a person outside their country of origin who is in need of international protection because of feared persecution or a serious threat to their life, physical integrity or freedom in their country of origin as a result of persecution, armed conflict, violence, massive violation of human rights or serious public disorder.

Asylum seeker is a general term for a person who intends to seek or is awaiting a decision on their request for international protection. When someone crosses an international border seeking safety, they often need to apply to be legally recognised as a refugee. In some countries, 'asylum seeker' is used as a legal term referring to a person who has applied for refugee status or a complementary international protection status and has not received a final decision on their claim. It can also refer to a person who has not yet submitted an application but may intend to do so. Not every asylum seeker will ultimately be recognised as a refugee, but every refugee is initially an asylum seeker. An asylum seeker may not be sent back to their country of origin until their asylum claim has been examined through a fair procedure. They are entitled to certain minimum standards of treatment, pending determination of their status.

Temporary protected status involves the assessment of international protection needs based on circumstances in a country of origin, typically to expedite access to protection services in situations of mass displacement. However, the arrangement must meet minimum standards of treatment that reflect international refugee and human rights law obligations, and the intention is not to displace existing protection status determination instruments.

For clarity, in this exercise we are focusing on refugees and asylum seekers (including those with temporary protected status, TPS). However, if your institution has services or infrastructure that pertain to immigrants, migrants, internally displaced people, stateless people or returnees (refugees who have returned to their country of origin) which are also applicable to refugees and/or asylum seekers, please consider these in your response.

- Please note that the invitation to participate in this survey may reach several persons within each institution. However, we need only one comprehensive answer per institution, which represents the perspective of the entire institution. Therefore, we kindly invite you to coordinate internally before replying to the survey.
